WSA Co stands to benefit from Mr Millett's recent senior management experience in the aviation and engineering sectors. Leading the Property and Procurement Divisions at Qantas for almost nine years as Qantas Group General Manager, Mr Millett was responsible for delivering the airline's Domestic Terminal Redevelopment projects at Sydney (Kingsford Smith) and Melbourne airports, as well as having accountability for fleet procurement.
